## Of Ohio United Patch Qualification Criteria

- 1. With two or more riders, visit three posts in your district in one day.
- 2. With two or more riders, visit an out-of-district American Legion Riders Post.
- 3. With one or more riders (may be done solo), attend a \*function\* at 7 of your ALR districts posts. If your District only has four Posts, they must do all four of them, then choose anywhere for the other three. If a District has over seven Posts, you can choose any seven in your district.

A function is a bike night, wing night, Steak night, etc. This is not a visit. The intent is to support the posts functions. This does not have to be an ALR function. Any post function qualifies.

- 4. Assist at an ALR function at another ALR Post in post in your district.
- 5. Assist at an ALR function in a different District.

Patches will be awarded four times a year. (At each State meeting) so all chapters can participate and be a part of the ceremony. You can take as long as you need to in order to complete these 5 rules. All paperwork must be received 30 days in advance of the scheduled day of the meeting, along with payment to cover cost of the Patch itself (cost unknown at this time.) The State Rider Director (Mindy Hinkle) is handling the Patch design and presentation of the Award. Carl Shortridge will be fielding any questions and complaints, along with your paperwork. They will be awarded at each of our quarterly ALR Meetings. All paperwork must be recieved 30 days in advance of the scheduled day of the meeting, along with \$10 payment to cover cost of the Patch itself and a Certificate of Unity. The State Rider Director (Mindy Hinkle) is handling the Patch design and presentation of the Award. Carl Shortridge will be fielding any questions and complaints, along with your paperwork.
